that we, Edmund P. Stiles, E. C. Bartholomew,
J. T. Fulmore, Walter Lips and H. E. Shelley
humbly associate ourselves into a body corporate
to be designated and hereafter known as
"Highland Park Cemetery Association."
The purposes of said body corporate shall be
the establishment and maintenance of a public
Cemetery adjacent to the City of Austin, Texas.

The place for the transaction of its business
shall be Austin, Texas.

The term for which it shall exist shall be
fifty years.

The number of its directors shall be
five and the names and residences of those
who shall act in said capacity for the first
year of the existence of said Corporation are as
follows.

The Capital Stock of said Corporation shall be

of shares into which it shall be divided is six
hundred.
